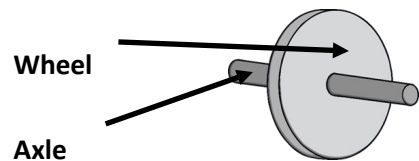
mechanisms

Dynamics - how quiet or loud the music is played

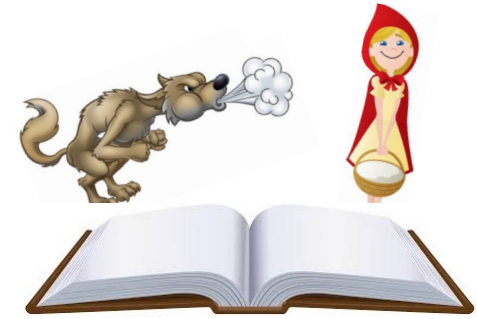
Melody - the tune, or musical line of notes, that our brains hear as one unit
