Dear parents and carers,

YEAR 4 YORKSHIRE WILDLIFE PARK TRIP

On **Monday 21 June** we will be taking all the children in year 4 to the **Yorkshire Wildlife Park**. The trip will support the children's science learning during the summer term. The children will be supervised by a Boston West member of staff to explore the wildlife park in small groups before taking part in a lesson linked to our learning lead by the wildlife park education team.

The cost of the trip will be £15 per child, which includes the coach and entrance to the park itself.

We ask for a voluntary contribution of £15 to be paid to the school by Friday 28 May. Please also print off and return the attached parental permission slip or send it via email to info@bwacademy.co.uk. Please make the subject of the email Y4 YWP trip. Due to Anthem Trust policy, if the slip is not returned your child will be unable to attend this trip due to some of it taking place outside of normal school hours. In the event of insufficient contributions, the trip may not be able to go ahead.

Payment requests will now be sent via Parent Hub. You may need to update the app to receive the latest information. If you have any problems setting this up, please contact the school office.

The coach will be leaving promptly at **8:15am** therefore you will need to ensure your child **arrives at school by 8:05am**. Year 4 staff will be available from **7:50am** to allow the children plenty of time to arrive at school. The children will enter school via the normal Year 3/4 gate. The coach will be leaving the park at 2.30pm with the aim to **arrive back at school for 4pm**. A reminder of this information will be sent via parent mail closer to the time.

The Yorkshire Wildlife Park has been risk assessed for COVID-19 safety and is currently using safety measures such as a one-way system and additional sanitising stations. The children and staff will follow current government regulations at the time of the trip.

Please make sure your child brings a packed lunch and a drink. Please also ensure they are dressed appropriately for the weather conditions of the day. No money is required as there will not be time to visit the gift shop.
