Y3 Trip to Peterborough

Dear parents and carers

On **Tuesday 15 June**, the children in both Y3 classes will be going on a visit to Flag Fen, in Peterborough, as part of their learning about the Stone Age.

The coach will leave school at 9am that morning. **It is essential that your child arrives at school on time that day as the bus will not be able to wait for latecomers.**

We **aim to return to school by 3pm**, traffic permitting. Parents/carers will be notified of any change of arrival time via Parent Hub.

During the day, each class will take part in different Stone Age workshops run by the staff at the site at Flag Fen. This will enhance their learning about the period of history we are studying. Look out on our website and school social media accounts for photos of them in action.

All children **must wear their school uniform** for the trip and bring suitable outdoor coat and footwear. They will also need to bring a packed lunch and a drink (**please do not book a hot meal on the day of the trip unless it is the packed lunch**). There is **NO NEED to bring any money or cameras**.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure that they are given the appropriate medication. If a further tablet is required for the return journey, please place this in a clearly marked envelope with your child's name and instructions for taking. This should be handed to their class teacher on the morning of the trip.

The cost of the trip is £14.50 per child, for which we kindly request a voluntary contribution **by Friday 11 June** at the latest. If for any reason you have difficulty making this payment, please contact the school in confidence. Should sufficient contributions not be received, the trip may be cancelled. **Payment requests will now be sent via ParentHub, you may need to update the app to receive the latest information. If you have any problems setting this up, please contact the school office.**
