



Year 1 Harvest

Science/ Geography

Seasons— a year is made up of four seasons. Each season usually last 3 months. The four seasons are; spring, summer, autumn and winter



Weather— sun, rain, wind, snow etc. Weather varies from day to day, season to season

Seasonal changes— changes that take place as the seasons change. E.g. winter to spring, spring to summer etc

DT/ TOPIC

Levers and sliders— mechanisms that make things move

Harvest— when farmers gather ripe crops from the fields

Harvest Festival— a celebration of food that is grown on the land



Produce— farm produced crops including fruit and vegetables

Crops— grains, fruit and vegetables grown in large amounts



Combine Harvester— a machine used to harvest different crops



Maths

Total— the whole amount

More— more than/ a greater amount

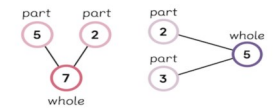
Less— less than/ fewer/ a smaller amount

Equal— the same as

Inequality symbols— used when comparing numbers (more than, less than, equal to)



Part-whole model— used to represent/ partition numbers



Addition— adding two amounts together to find the total. When adding, the total amount gets bigger/ greater

Subtraction— to take away a given amount. When subtracting, the total number becomes less/ gets smaller.

Art

Print/ printing— transferring patterns/ images onto other surfaces. E.g. fruit printing, hand prints etc.

Shades— how light or dark a colour is



Kandinsky— a famous artist known for creating abstract art.



PSHE

Family— a group of people who are related to each other

Friendship— a relationship between friends

Emotions— how we feel. E.g. happy, sad, worried, excited etc.
