Music

Music sessions this term will be focussed around composing and performing a WW2 themed song which can be sung in two parts.

History

During this term our main topic focus is WW2. We will be comparing features of life in the past with life today, including ideas, beliefs and experiences. We will be exploring life as an evacuee and as a soldier drawing on key events of the past.

DT

We will be exploring our understanding of structures and how to ensure that they are strong.

Geography

Our lessons will focus around using maps to locate countries involved during WW2 and also using maps of the school to follow and create trails.

Our focus areas are:

English

Our text types this term are:

We are also going to be developing our reading comprehension skills and our grammatical knowledge.

We will be developing our clay techniques to create structures as well as working on our skills to paint with a limited palette.


PSHE
